

RESOLUTION NO. 11-18

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE NORTHEAST OHIO REGIONAL SEWER DISTRICT PURSUANT TO THE DISTRICT'S MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY AS REFLECTED IN RESOLUTION NO. 05-16 TO PURCHASE A STREET SWEEPER FOR \$105,688.68 AND A LEAF VACUUM TRUCK FOR \$182,450.00 BY USING THE CITY'S COMMUNITY COST-SHARE FUNDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY FOR THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE.

WHEREAS, the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District, as a component of implementing a regional stormwater management program, manages a financial account for the City of East Cleveland termed the "*Community Cost-Share Account*" that is for the aggregation and dissemination of funds derived from revenues collected from the Stormwater Fee; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Community Cost-Share Account is to provide funding to assist the City with District-approved Equipment Purchases through the Community Cost Share Program; and

WHEREAS, the Community Cost-Share Program funds are used for construction, operation, and maintenance of the Local Stormwater System, including administrative costs directly associated with such Equipment Purchases as well as costs related to repair or upgrade; and

WHEREAS, THE District supports the Community Cost-Share Street Sweeper and Leaf Vacuum Truck Purchases (the "Equipment Purchases") as Community Cost-Share Projects proposed by the City; and

Now therefore, in consideration of the foregoing, the payment and the mutual promises contained in this Agreement, the parties agree to the terms and conditions as outlined in Exhibit A.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of East Cleveland, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio, four-fifths (4/5) of all members therein concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby empowered and directed on behalf of the City to enter into a Community Cost Share Agreement with the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District for the purchase of a Street Sweeper for \$105,688.68 and a Leaf Vacuum Truck for \$182,450.00.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all such deliberations of this Council and any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public safety and welfare to allow for expeditious implementation of said improvements and provided it receives the affirmative vote of four-fifths (4/5) of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.




