

RESOLUTION NO. 13-13

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PREPARE SPECIFICATIONS AND BID DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO PROCURE 75 STREET LIGHT POLES, 100 HPS ROADWAY LIGHT FIXTURES, 1,500 FEET OF #14 WIRE AND 6,600 FEET OF #6 WIRE; AND DECLARING AN IMMEDIATE PUBLIC PEACE, PROPERTY, HEALTH, WELFARE AND SAFETY EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer/Director of Service of the City of East Cleveland has identified that the purchase of street light poles and related accessories are required to further the public interest; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, welfare and safety in that it is necessary to authorize the development of specifications and to provide for solicitation of bids for the purchase of 75 Street Light Poles, 100 HPS Roadway Light Fixtures, 1,500 feet of #14 Wire and 6,600 feet of #6 Wire.

WHEREAS, the purchase of these materials is to be made by utilizing Community Development Block Grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$130,000.00.

WHEREAS, this Resolution is submitted as an emergency for the public peace, property, health, welfare and safety in that sufficient nighttime street lighting is critical to ensure the safety and welfare of the public and further provide a sense of security that will encourage residential development and business growth.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of East Cleveland, Ohio, four-fifths (4/5) concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the purchase of 75 Street Light Poles, 100 HPS Roadway Light Fixtures, 1,500 feet of #14 Wire and 6,600 feet of #6 Wire.

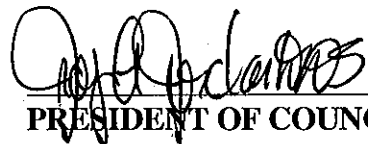
SECTION 2. That the Mayor and City Engineer/Director of Service are hereby authorized to develop specifications and prepare bid documents to accomplish these desired objectives.

SECTION 3. That the purchase of these materials is to be made by utilizing Community Development Block Grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$130,000.00

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all such deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of four-fifths (4/5) of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

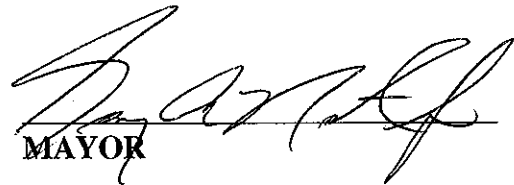
