

RESOLUTION 15-18

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF EAST CLEVELAND, A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$21,467 FROM THE NORTHEAST OHIO PUBLIC ENERGY COUNCIL AND TO APPROPRIATE SUCH FUNDS TO IMPLEMENT ENERGY SAVINGS OR ENERGY INFRASTRUCTURE MEASURES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of East Cleveland IS A MEMBER OF THE Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council ("NOPEC") and is eligible for one or more NOPEC Energized Community Grant(s) for 2018 ("NEC Grant(s)" as provided for in the NEC Grant Program guidelines; and

WHEREAS, THE City of East Cleveland wishes to enter into a Grant Agreement with NOPEC, Inc. in the form attached to this Resolution to receive one or more NEC, Inc. in the form attached.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Council of the City of East Cleveland, Ohio, four-fifths (4/5) of all members concurring that;

SECTION 1. This Council of the City of East Cleveland (the "Council" finds and determines that it is in its best interest to accept the NEC Grant for 2018, and authorizes the Mayor to execute the Grant Agreement with NOPEC, Inc., in the form attached.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.


SECTION 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of East Cleveland; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor of the City of East Cleveland.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is further authorized to execute any and all additional documents and forms necessary to secure and/or expend such NOPEC funds.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all such deliberations of this Council and any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.


SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and/or safety of the inhabitants of the City, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of four-fifths (4/5) of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


