Governor Mike DeWine Mandated Ohio Closings

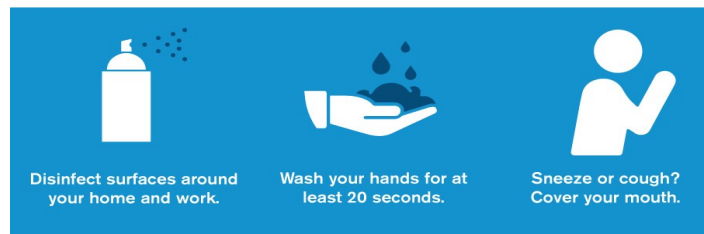
As of March 19, 2020 the following are official closings:

- 52 Driver Exam locations
- All hair and nail salons, tattoo parlors
- All schools, colleges, and universities
- All bars and restaurants
- Government Offices and Business implement restrictions and safety measures
