A RESOLUTION IMPLEMENTING AND ADHERING TO PREVIOUSLY PASSED RESOLUTIONS 104-11 A RESOLUTION IN FURTHERANCE OF SECTION 60(f) OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF EAST CLEVELAND PROVIDING THAT THE MAYOR SUBMIT TO COUNCIL, BY THE END OF EACH FISCAL YEAR, A SEPARATE SCHEDULE FOR EACH DEPARTMENT SHOWING THE THINGS NECESSARY FOR THE DEPARTMENT TO DO DURING THE YEAR, AND WHICH OF ANY DESIRABLE THINGS IT OUGHT TO DO IF POSSIBLE.; 105-11A RESOLUTION IN FURTHERANCE OF SECTION 67 OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF EAST CLEVELAND PROVIDING THAT THE FINANCE DIRECTOR SHALL PROVIDE TO COUNCIL A QUARTERLY REPORT OF AGGREGATE RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES BY DEPARTMENT, WHICH REPORT SHALL BE PUBLISHED BY COUNCIL IN A MANNER THAT PROVIDES FULL PUBLICITY.; 107-11 A RESOLUTION IN FURTHERANCE OF SECTION 60(e) OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF EAST CLEVELAND PROVIDING THAT THE FINANCE DIRECTOR SHALL SUBMIT TO COUNCIL, ON A QUARTERLY BASIS, A DETAILED INVENTORY OF SUPPLIES AND MATERIAL ON HAND AND THE VALUE THEREOF AT THE DATE OF PREPARATION.; 108-11 A RESOLUTION PROVIDING THAT THE FINANCE DIRECTOR SHALL CERTIFY TO COUNCIL, BY THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR, THAT ALL SUPER-BLANKET PURCHASE ORDERS IN PLACE DURING THE FISCAL YEAR HAVE TERMINATED OR WILL TERMINATE BY THE LAST DAY OF THE YEAR. THE FINANCE DIRECTOR SHALL ALSO PROVIDE INFORMATION TO COUNCIL REGARDING ANY ANTICIPATED SUPER-BLANKET PURCHASE ORDERS OR BLANKET PURCHASE ORDERS THAT ARE PLANNED FOR THE UPCOMING FISCAL YEAR BY MARCH 31ST OF EACH FISCAL YEAR.; AND 109-11 A RESOLUTION IN FURTHERANCE OF SECTION 60(f) OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF EAST CLEVELAND PROVIDING THAT THE MAYOR SHALL SUBMIT TO COUNCIL, ON A QUARTERLY BASIS, A SCHEDULE OF ESSENTIAL PERSONNEL PER DEPARTMENT AS SET FORTH IN EXHIBIT A.
